This activity is for Beavers but any section or leaders could take part too!


# **Beaver Challenge 1**

### What you need:

- Nursery Rhyme Book or Access to the internet
- Mobile Phone (to use to film with)
- Paper
- Pen or Pencil



A nursery rhyme is a traditional poem or song for children in Britain and many other countries.



- 1. Find a nursery rhyme in a book or on the internet.
- 2. Once you have found your favourite nursery rhyme, use a mobile phone to make a short film of it by drawing pictures or acting out the story of the rhyme (you could dress up too if you like).
- 3. You could ask other members of your family to help you and remember to recite the nursery rhyme as part of the film.

Why not make a series of Nursery Rhyme Films to share with family and friends.

While you are researching the nursery rhyme to film, take a few minutes to learn about the origins of the rhyme, often they were written with a hidden meaning.

Did you know that the rhyme "Ring a Ring of Roses" is a very early one that refers to the Great Plague of 1665.
