
CHALLENGE BOX HOUSE PARTY INSTRUMENTS

What you need:

- Household Buckets, Pots and Pans
- Empty Boxes etc.
- Wooden Spoons



Second only to the human voice, percussion instruments are believed to be the very first musical instruments ever created.

Dating back as far as 6000 B.C.E., people were using

percussion to communicate. African drums made of animal hide were used to send signals across long distances.

- This is your chance to communicate with others using you own home-made house instruments.
- 1. Using household items such as tubs, boxes, pots and pans, create some percussion instruments to play.
- 2. Wooden spoons make great drumsticks.
- 3. Form your own 'band' with members of your family.
- 4. Practice together to play a rhythm with your instruments.
