Explorer Challenge 2

What you need:

- Access to the Internet
- Garden Foliage etc.
- An vivid imagination !

How to make it:

Famous paintings hang in art galleries across the world, you have probably seen more than you realise in books, on television programme or when you are using the internet.

1. Use the internet to search for some famous paintings...

Here are a few ideas to get you started:

- Mona Lisa – Leonardo da Vinci
- The Scream – Edvard Munch
- American Gothic – Grant Wood
- Whistlers Mother – James Abbott McNeill
- Sunflowers – Vincent Van Gogh

2. Take a snapshot of the painting you choose to re-create.
3. Re-construct your version of the famous artwork from materials found in your garden.
4. Take a photo of your “painting” and then send the two pictures to the Media Box – box-jam@norfolkscouts.org.uk
