### Scout Challenge 2

#### What you need:

- Access to the internet
- Recycling or Rubbish Materials
- Sticky Tape or Glue
- Scissors

#### How to make it:

Our world is full of interesting buildings, some dating back hundreds of years and some built recently.

1. Use the internet to search for some famous buildings from around the world...

Here are a few ideas to get you started:

- Italy – Rome: The Pantheon (c.113 – 125)
- France – Paris: the Eiffel Tower (c.1887-1889)
- Russia – St. Petersburg: Church of the Saviour (c.1883-1907)
- Great Britain – London: The Gherkin Building (c.2001 - 2003)

2. Take a snapshot of the building you choose to re-create.
3. Re-construct your version of the famous building from rubbish and re-cycling.

#### Take it to the next level:

#### Safety Notes:

**Online Access:** Supervise young people when they're online and give them advice about staying safe.

**Scissors / Sharp Objects:** Supervise young people appropriately when they're using scissors. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

**Glue and Solvents:** Supervise young people appropriately when they're using glue and solvent products. Make sure there's plenty of ventilation. Be aware of any medical conditions which could be affected by glue or solvent use and make adjustments as needed.

**Rubbish and Recycling:** All items should be clean and suitable for this activity.
