
CRAFT BOX SCIENCE - PUFFY PAINT

This activity is for Beavers but any section or leaders could take part too!

Beaver Science Challenge

What you need:

- 125g Plain Flour
- 240ml Water
- 240g Shaving Foam
- Food Colouring
- Large Freezer Bags (zip-lock ones best)
- Scissors
- Paper



- 1. Open the freezer bag and add the flour and water.
- 2. Close the bag and mix well so that there are no lumps or clumps.
- 3. Open the bag and add a few drops of food colouring and the shaving foam.
- 4. Close the bag and squeeze the bag gently to mix all the ingredients together.
- 5. Cut the corner off the freezer bag and use the bag to "pipe" your puffy picture the bigger the corner cut off the thicker the piping will be.
- 6. Pipe onto a large sheet of paper.

Get more Crafty:

Why not make several bags of different coloured puffy paint and create some large-scale patterns on your driveway or in your garden and when completed, photograph it and wash away with more water.

Safety Notes:

Scissors / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using scissors. Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

Food / Allergies: Check for allergies before you begin. Make sure you have suitable areas for storing and preparing food and avoid cross contamination of different foods. All activities must be safely managed.
