Explorer Trad Craft Challenge

What you need:

- Access to the Internet
- Scrap Booking Paper (or Magazine Pages can be used)
- BBQ Skewer
- PVA Glue
- Cotton Bud or Tine Paint Brush
- Clear Nail Varnish
 (Glitter Nail Varnish for best effect)
- Scissors



How to make it:

These traditional paper beads can be made into a bracelet as great presents or can also be made into decorations to hang on a Christmas Tree. Paper Bead making is thought to have been based on traditional African crafts.

Safety Notes:
