What you need:

- Access to the Internet
- Paper
 17cm x 17cm
- Scissors
 (to cut the paper into a square)



How to make it:

Paper was first invented in China around 105 A.D. and was brought to Japan by monks in the sixth century. Handmade paper was a luxury item only available to a few, and paper folding in ancient Japan was strictly used for ceremonial purposes.
