# CRAFT BOX SCIENCE - MAGIC SNOW

This activity is for Scouts but any section or leaders could take part too!

## **Scout Science Challenge**

#### What you need:

- 240g Baking Soda
- 120ml Water
- LARGE Mixing Bowl
- Wooden Spoon



### How to make it:

Christmas is coming – snow is on the way...

- 1. Put the baking soda in the freezer overnight so that it gives a chilly feel to the snow.
- 2. Put the frozen baking soda into a large bowl and slowly add the water, mixing with the spoon until a snow-like consistency is achieved.

As water is added the baking soda turns into snow!

## **Get more Crafty:**

Why not have a snowball fight in the summer by making the magic snow into snow balls and have a snowball fight!
