LEAF CREATURES

This activity is for Cubs
but any section or leaders
could take part !

Cub Leaf Creatures

What you need:

- Leaves – a good variety of shapes and sizes
- Paper
- Glue
- Pens or Markers
- Wiggly Eyes (optional)



How to make it:

When out on a woodland walk or exploring a local park, collect a variety of fallen leaves.

1. Look carefully at leaves and think about how to make them into the body parts of animals, birds or insects.
2. Arrange the leaves on a piece of paper, moving the leaves around until it look like the creature you are creating.
3. Stick the leaves to the piece of paper and leave to dry.
4. Add wiggly eyes or draw on eyes and legs with a pen or marker pen – think about how thick the lines should be.
5. Use the creature creation to make a picture.

Get more Crafty:

Think about other leafy creatures that
could be made into pictures.
Why not make some cards to share.



Safety Notes:

Scissors / Sharp Objects: Supervise young people appropriately when using scissors.

Store all sharp objects securely, out of the reach of young people.

Glue and Solvents: Supervise young people appropriately when they're using glue and solvent products. Make sure there's plenty of ventilation. Be aware of any medical conditions which could be affected by glue or solvent use and make adjustments as needed.

Gardening and Nature: Wash your hands after the activity has finished and wear gloves if needed.
